INTRODUCE YOUR CLASS TO INDIGENOUS CULTURE @ MĀDAHÒKÌ FARM

All guests to Madahoki Farm will be welcomed with a traditional song and have an interactive introduction to the diversity of Indigenous culture across Canada. Includes some free time for the group to explore the farm animals and marketplace. (1 hour)

Schedule in some extra time to enjoy a self guided walk on our Legacy Trail (30 - 60 minutes) learn about some of our traditional plants and their uses, the seven grandfather teachings and Algonquin names for local animals and birds through the trail signage.
